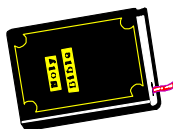

Saturday, March 4, 2006 the months of hard work paid off as the West Columbia Pre Teen and Teen age teams managed to win, over stiff competition, and retain their titles as **South Carolina State Wide Bible Bowl Champions!**

The Adult team also did well against very tough competition but unfortunately were eliminated before the final rounds. The Georgetown congregation was very competitive at all levels. They fielded 4 adult teams! All four were very good and made it to the semi-final rounds and had to play against each other to find the best team.

The St. Andrews Road church of Christ in Columbia, SC hosted 64 teams from 16 congregations across the state for the 7th consecutive year. Competition was “double elimination”. A team had to lose 2 matches before being eliminated. A match consisted of 10 questions from the Old Testament books of Obadiah, Haggai, Zechariah and Malachi. “Yes/No”, multiple choice or fill in the blank type questions were **not** allowed. Contestants had to know their Bibles—and they did! The Teen Team was undefeated. The Pre-Teens lost only once in the final round to North Charleston before winning over them the second time to gain their victory.

Our thanks to the St. Andrews Road congregation for hosting the event; to Mike Moore and Ernest Richards who did a difficult job very well; to the judges; and to all the others that worked hard to make this wonderful event a great success. Our prayer is that all will be better spiritually for their work and study.
