Good Works

When we think of good works we'll probably remember **Dorcas** (Acts 9:36) who provided clothing for many without, and **Cornelius** who “gave much alms to the people” (Acts 10:1). Certainly we'll think of **Jesus** who did so much for so many people. We might remember others who've touched our lives by their good works. Wishing we could do better ourselves, we might think that some people are just "BORN" to do good works. But did you know, *all* of us are "BORN" to do good works?:

"For we are his workmanship, CREATED in Christ Jesus UNTO GOOD WORKS, which God hath before ordained that we should WALK in them."

- Ephesians 2:10

Good works aren't just for **some** people, they're for *all* of us who have been born anew in Jesus Christ. The Lord tells us we need to, we **must, walk** in them, *continually*, not just take a **step** and quit. Are you?

One good reason to do so is that we all want to **fruitful** for the Lord. We don't want to be cut off and cast into the fire (Matthew 3:10). The Lord doesn't leave any confusion on how **we can be fruitful** either:

"That ye might walk WORTHY of the Lord unto ALL pleasing, being FRUITFUL in every GOOD WORK, and increasing in the knowledge of God."

- Colossians 1:10

Remember though, a good **action** isn't a good **work** unless we do it with a good **heart**:

"And though I bestow *all* my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not CHARITY (LOVE) it profits me nothing."

- 1 Corinthians 13:3

We **must** think of others and help them, motivated by love towards them just as God, out of love, gave Jesus to us (Romans 5:8) even when we were sinners. Do good to others, and truly God will welcome us—as **obedient, loving** children He is pleased to call his own, to heaven.
