

TO WHOM SHALL WE GO? THE NECESSITY OF PRAYER

Prayer is an expression of our gratitude: “**Rejoice evermore ... in everything give thanks**” (1 Thess 5:16-18) and also of our need: “**Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.**” (Heb 4:16) The mercy and grace we must have can only come from God. Prayer helps us obtain them (Acts 8:22).

But **more** than that: Prayer is a demonstration and **proof** of our faith and trust in God. Prayer shows God we think of ourselves as His **children**. Prayer shows our **submission** and **union** to Him—that He indeed **is** our God and Father.

God tested Abraham’s faith (Genesis 22:2,12). Our faith also is tested every day. Do we pass the test? Do we go to God in **prayer** for what we need? The message we send in our prayers isn’t as much the words as the fact that we’re **doing** it. Prayer is a **demonstration** that we **know** we can not do it alone; that we can not provide for ourselves. Solomon prayed “**i am but a little child: i know not how to go out or come in.**” (1 Kings 3:7) and it **pleased** God (v10).

Prayer shows God we know we have a need that only He can provide. And when we go to God in prayer acknowledging this, as Solomon did, God will be pleased and give us much **more** than we ask as He did Solomon (1 Kings 3:10-13). We must know that the **only** place we can get what we need is from God.

Read **Luke 11:5-9**. If we **don’t** go to God, if we don’t **importune** Him as the example here shows, then we’re saying we either don’t want it badly enough, or that we think we can get it elsewhere. Is **that** the message you want to send to God? That his mercy and grace are **not** important! If not then **PRAY!** Be as Peter who cried in desperation to the Lord when asked if he would go elsewhere: “**Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life.** (John 6:68)

By prayer we **show** and **prove** to our Heavenly Father our: **gratitude, humility, faith, trust, submission** and the fact that we **are** His children. Prayer is an **essential** demonstration of our faith in God – that we have no other god but Him.
