little things are GREAT

Sometimes we're overwhelmed by the size of a job we have to do. We wonder **“where do I start?”** Sometimes we spend so much time wondering, getting ready, and looking for the best thing to do, that we never do anything at all. Nothing gets done, and then we get even more discouraged and quit all together.

But, that's a problem we've made for ourselves. The Lord didn't lay such a great burden on us. He didn't tell us we had to do it all at once! He gave us time: **“If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross DAILY, and follow me.”** - Luke 9:23

A little fruit, every once and awhile, is **so** much better than **no** fruit at all! Let's start right now. There are people we can call or visit. We can think and pray for one another. We can read a book, a chapter, a verse from the Bible. But if we don't plant the seed, how can we expect fruit to grow? If we don't sow, we can't reap. Why do you think our life here is “Three score years”? We have to develop, to grow, to build. We can't just do one GREAT thing and then quit. The temple of the Jews was made with many stones. Laid up one at a time. So are we. It takes time and effort. Let's not be discouraged, our **little** efforts will add up! A kind word here, a visit or call there, a mention of the church and the bible to a neighbor. These are good works which will bear eternal fruit:

“To them who by patient CONTINUANCE in well doing seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life.” - Romans 2:7

Let's start the new year, honoring our God by **doing** the **little** things He asks.
