Churches of Christ

The church of Christ is a non-denominational body of Christians. We have no earthly headquarters. Our leader is in Heaven at the right hand of God. We are not affiliated with any organization such as the National Council of Churches. Rather, each local congregation of the churches of Christ looks to God and His word for guidance. We believe the Bible to be the inspired word of God and that it furnishes us completely for every spiritual need. We stand for a return to New Testament faith and practice. And we are confident that by believing and doing what New Testament Christians did, we can be the same kind of Christians they were. We know this is right before God. We see no need, therefore, for denominational names, creeds and organizations.

Jesus said that worship must be in spirit and in truth (Jn. 4:24). Worship among churches of Christ follows the Scriptural pattern.

When the Lord established the church, He organized it into local autonomous congregations, with each taking care of its own affairs. He made no provisions for a national or international headquarters. In matters of faith all are to be guided by the New Testament. In other decisions, each congregation was to govern itself.

The work of the church Jesus built was to preach the gospel, as well as edify its members and care for the needy. Churches of Christ do not exist as political tools, nor do they exist as recreation clubs. Their work is spiritual, doing what God intended the church to do.

Remember, Jesus built His church. It is found in the New Testament. We can be a part of it by letting the Bible be our only guide.

YOU MIGHT AS WELL STAY HOME

FORMING THE HEART

You can cut a tree and take it to the saw mill. It might be crooked with a limb here and a knot there. The saw will square the log and makes it straight as an arrow, but the *heart* of the tree is still crooked. Judas Iscariot was like that. He *outwardly* conformed, but inwardly, his heart was still crooked (Matthew 26:14-16).

Many think if we *do* good things, we'll *become* good—our heart will become good. Some ask themselves: **WWJD**—What Would Jesus Do. And they're plumb wrong! If that were all it took, the Pharisees would have been good and pleasing in God's sight. But, they weren't, as Jesus told us:

Matthew 23:28: "Even so you also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but within you are full of hypocrisy and iniquity."

Jesus told them to cleanse first the inside *so* the outside might be clean! *That* is the way it's done. But, we can't work directly on our hearts (Jeremiah 17:9,10). Instead we form our hearts by changing our minds as the Lord told us:

Romans 12:2: "But be ye transformed by the renewing of your MIND"

We need to empty our minds of thoughts of self and replace them with thoughts of God that we get from His word—the Bible. This is how God works on us—through His word. This takes time. We must work at it every day, purging ourselves of self and studying God's word. Our Lord told us to do this very thing:

Luke 9:23: "If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me."

Jesus meant it! He took up his cross to die! So must we - daily! Die to self so we can live for God, feeding on His word so we might grow (1 Peter 2:2).

To form our hearts, it must be clear in our minds that we've been bought!

2 Corinthians. 5:15 "And that he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again."

By the grace of God we can be redeemed if we do His will. We can belong to God and gain victory over death. It's so easy to find rest:

Matthew 11:29 "Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for I am meek and lowly in heart: and ye shall find rest unto your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."

Remember: "Blessed *are* they which do hunger and thirst after righteousness: for they shall be filled." Matthew 5:6
