SEEING SATAN'S SERVANTS

God, through Paul, warned the church that Satan would try to take them away from Christ: "I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ." (2 Cor 11:3).

He continued in that chapter and told us <u>how</u> Satan would do this – through his (Satan's) ministers—false teachers: "For such *are* false apostles, deceitful workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. Therefore *it is* no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness;" (2 Cor 11:13-15)

God wants us to be wary and <u>watch</u> for these false apostles (Luke 12:37, Acts 20:29-31). He commended the church in Ephesus for doing so: "and thou hast tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and hast found them <u>liars</u>:" (Rev 2:2)

How did the Ephesians do this? How are **we** to do this? Again, God tells us in that same chapter: "For if he that cometh preacheth <u>another</u> Jesus, whom we have not preached, or *if* ye receive <u>another</u> spirit, which ye have not received, or <u>another</u> gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with *him*." (2 Cor 11:4)

We are to compare what we hear from men, to what God told us through the Apostles; whose word we have recorded in the Holy Bible. And His word has not changed: "ye should earnestly contend for the faith which was <u>once</u> delivered unto the saints." (Jude 1:3) "But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed." (Gal 1:8). If what a man says contradicts God's word in **any** way, he is the minister of Satan.

God wants us to be like the church in Berea who: "... searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so" (Acts 17:11).

What was Satan's lie to Eve? "And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall <u>not</u> surely die" (Gen 3:2). Satan <u>contradicted</u> God then; that's what his servants do today.

To see Satan's servants today, just compare what they say to the Bible. If they contradict God's word, in <u>any</u> way, they are Satan's servants! Have men told you, you don't need to be baptized to be saved? Read Mark 16:16, Acts 22:16, 1 Peter 3:21. Have you heard: "once saved, always saved"? Not from God. Read the first paragraph here again. Satan's servants are out there—beware!

Satan Must Love Calvinism

The doctrine of Calvinism is named after John Calvin, and its main points are summarized by the acronym "TULIP" – Total hereditary depravity, Unconditional election, Limited atonement, Irresistible grace, and Perseverance of the saints. Calvinists believe that every single event, whether it is good or bad, happens because God ordained it to happen. This doctrine is deadly, and it seems to permeate nearly every denomination in one form or another. I am sure that Satan must love Calvinism, because it confuses people about the nature of God, His Plan of salvation, and so many other critical spiritual issues. Please notice some specific reasons why I believe that Satan must love Calvinism:

- Because it teaches that God causes people to be tempted, and makes them do evil things However, the Bible does not teach this! (James 1:13-16; 1 Peter 1:16, etc.).
- Because it teaches that people are basically nothing more than robots, having no free will of their own The Bible does not teach this! (Deuteronomy 30:19; Joshua 24:15; Acts 2:40, etc.).
- Because it teaches that innocent newborn babies have souls blackened with sin The Bible does not teach this! (2 Samuel 12:23; Ezekiel 18:20; Matthew 18:3, 19:14, etc.).
- Because it teaches that God will save certain people whom He chooses, without any conditions to be met on their part The Bible does not teach this! (Luke 13:3; Acts 2:38, 40; 2 Corinthians 7:1; James 4:8; Jude 21, etc.).
- Because it teaches that the Lord's invitation for salvation was only for individuals arbitrarily chosen by God to be saved The Bible does not teach this! (John 3:16; Matthew 11:28-30; Revelation 22:17).
- Because it teaches that Jesus only died for individuals who were fortunate enough to be predestined for salvation by God The Bible does not teach this! (John 3:16; Hebrews 2:9; 1 John 2:1, 2, etc.).
- Because it teaches that God is a capricious respecter of persons when it comes to salvation, not desiring that all men be saved The Bible does not teach this! (John 3:16; Acts 10:34; Romans 2:11; 1 Timothy 2:4; 1 Peter 1:17; 2 Peter 3:9, etc.).
- Because it teaches that if God chooses one for salvation, God cannot be resisted The Bible does not teach this! (Luke 7:30; John 12:42, 43; Acts 7:51, 13:46, etc.).
- Because it attempts to denigrate the power of the Word and the need for spreading the Gospel Why labor to spread the Gospel when God will supposedly draw men to Him by a direct operation of the Holy Spirit? The Bible does not teach this! (John 6:45; Mark 16:15, 16; Matthew 28:19, 20; 2 Thessalonians 2:14; Romans 1:16, 10:17, etc.).
- Because it leads "the elect" to believe that there is no need for them to study the Word of God The Bible does not teach this! (1 Timothy 4:13; 2 Timothy 2:15, 3:16, 17, etc.).
- Because it teaches that once a person is saved, there is no possibility of falling from grace The Bible does not teach this! (Galatians 5:4; Hebrews 3:6, 4:11, 6:4-6, 10:25-31, 10:35-39, 12:15, 12:25; 2 Peter 2:20-22; etc.).
