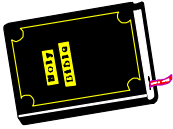

DON'T YOU HAVE ANY FUN?

Have you ever thought of this in regards to being a Christian? Does it seem maybe a little **wrong** for a Christian to “have fun”? While it **is** wrong for the church to provide worldly **entertainment**, it's **not** wrong for Christians to enjoy themselves. But as in all things, there are **right** ways and **wrong** ways to go about this. Think of David, who God said was a man after his own heart (Acts 13:22):

“I have REJOICED in the way of thy testimonies, as much as in ALL RICHES. I will meditate in thy precepts, and have respect unto thy ways. I will DELIGHT myself in thy statutes: I will not forget thy word.” - Psalm 119:14-16

Does this sound like a person who wasn't happy to you? Like a person who had no joy in what he was doing? No! But, **what** was it he was doing? Was it something of the **world**, or something from **God**? God seeks a **holy** people, separate from the world. Our “fun” should be holy too!

People tell us today to change the way we eat. When we want a snack, don't get a candy bar, get an apple instead. It's better for us and just as satisfying. They say that our desire for **junk food** is just a **habit**, that can, and should, be changed into a desire for more healthful food. (“Repentance” anyone! ☺)

Well, our idea of what's “Fun” should change also. We should want to do things that glorify God; that will build us up **eternally**, rather than enjoying the “empty calories” of worldly pleasures that last only a little while. We should want to help others above ourselves (Romans 15:1-3, Acts 20:35). We should enjoy God's word more than a novel or the Sunday funnies (Psalm 1:2). Remember, “Blessed are they who hunger and thirst after righteousness, for they shall be filled.” (Matthew 5:6) This is a promise from God. Do you believe it? Well, how are you acting?

The world's idea of “having fun” involves doing things of the world. Instead, let's be wise and remember what God has told us: “**And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.**” - **Colossians 3:17**. Let's go after the “True riches” that last forever. Let's be like our Lord who said “My meat is to do the will of Him that sent me”. Let's find fulfillment and true joy in being like Christ—Christians.
