I'M THANKFUL FOR WHAT JOSHUA DID NOT SAY

In Joshua's farewell address, he stood before the representatives of all the tribes of Israel and told them to make a decision. He said that they could either turn from God and serve idols, or they could turn to God and serve Him. Joshua told them what his decision was: "As for me and my house, we will serve the LORD" (Joshua 24:15). The leaders who represented the nation of Israel agreed. They said, "God forbid that we should forsake the LORD, to serve other gods" (24:16). I am so thankful for Joshua and his dedication. I am also grateful for what Joshua did *not* say.

I'm thankful that Joshua did not say, "My family will serve the Lord without me." Friends, so many wives and children are serving the Lord without fathers. Fathers should be the spiritual leaders of the home (Ephesians 5:23-25; 6:4). Fathers have an obligation to their families and God to set the spiritual tone of the home. God give us faithful fathers!

I'm thankful that Joshua did not say, "I will serve the Lord without my family." Sadly, some fathers must serve the Lord on their own, because they have wives who refuse to follow their lead. Fathers must maintain their faithfulness, and one day they may win their families to Christ.

I'm thankful that Joshua did not say, "My family and I will not serve the Lord." Entire families will be lost eternally because they refuse to serve the Lord. I cannot help but think that greater punishment will come upon fathers who have the duty of leading the home in the way it should go. May God give us Christian homes!

“ELDERS .. FEED THE FLOCK OF GOD” - 1 Peter 5:1,2

When we want to emphasize the importance of something today we might say it is a matter of the **gravest** importance—a matter of life or death. This rightly gets our attention. But there's something even more important than the grave and our physical death—it's our **spiritual** death, or life. The Apostle Paul charged Timothy, before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, the highest authorities, regarding this matter of ultimate importance—the judgment of our souls: “**I charge thee therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the quick and the dead at his appearing and his kingdom;**” - 2 Timothy 4:1 And what was the most important thing Timothy was to do to comply with this charge and ensure that the will of God and our Lord Jesus Christ that none perish, was carried out? It was quite simple: “**PREACH THE WORD!**” (2 Timothy 4:2) It doesn't matter what else we do—if we don't preach the word, we will have **failed** God's charge. The WORD OF GOD is sufficient to deliver souls from darkness and death to light and life and then to nurture them: “**As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby;**” - 1 Peter 2:2. Only the WORD OF GOD will produce the growth God wants. And God expects that growth of all of us: “**For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe.”** - Hebrews 5:12,13 Brothers and sisters, study God's word! Don't go elsewhere. Use and read your Bible—daily! It's a matter of the gravest importance.
