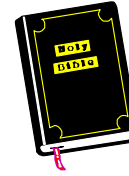

DOOR KNOCKING: We'd like all members that are physically able; to participate at least once in the door knocking campaign we'll be conducting each of the **3** Saturdays remaining before our Gospel meeting at the end of the month.
