ASCENDING TO HIM

The heart symbolizes our motives, intentions, attitudes and thoughts. Lifting up the soul symbolizes our worship and adoration of that which is greater. Swearing deceitfully reminds us of our speech.

Do you want to come into God's presence? Make sure that what you do is right and acceptable to God. Do you want to come into God's presence?
