"every disciple that is perfect shall be as his master." Luke 6:40b

PSALM 19

In Luke 13:3 the Lord told us, "except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish." Three things are necessary for repentance to salvation—to prevent our perishing:

- 1. Men must first recognize **HE IS** God and **seek** Him out.
- 2. They must then **LEARN** what He wants of them.
- 3. Finally, they must **OBEY**!

This has always been the case. **Psalm 19** is a beautiful illustration of these 3 points:

- 1) God has declared plainly, to all men, that HE IS in verses 1-6:
- "The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork. Day unto day uttereth speech, and night unto night sheweth knowledge. There is no speech nor language, where their voice is not heard. Their line is gone out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. In them hath he set a tabernacle for the sun, Which is as a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, and rejoices as a strong man to run a race. His going forth is from the end of the heaven, and his circuit unto the ends of it: and there is nothing hid from the heat thereof."
- 2) God has told us what we must **LEARN** in verses 7-9:
- "The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether."
- 3) God has told us to **OBEY** what we learn, in verses 10-14:
- "More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward. Who can understand his errors? cleanse thou me from secret faults. Keep back thy servant also from presumptuous sins; let them not have dominion over me: then shall I be upright, and I shall be innocent from the great transgression. Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer."

EXAMINE YOURSELF

This command from God was given for our own good. On Judgment Day, God doesn't want us to be found wanting; wanting of what <u>He expects</u> us to have as His children!. Everything we need to know is in His word, **2 Peter 1:3**, read it! All of it!

We examine ourselves by studying that word and comparing ourselves to what we find there. There is <u>no</u> other standard. Jesus said we will be judged by the Word He has spoken, **John 12:48.** Then we need to <u>test</u> ourselves to see if what we think is so: Am I serving God? Am I laying up treasure in Heaven? Do I see spiritually? What is of value to me? Do I act and <u>think</u> as if Jesus is in me? Am I looking up, reading and memorizing the scriptures given here?

Satan is working to pull the wool over our eyes so we won't see ourselves as God sees us. Don't be deceived. God isn't. You will reap what you sow. Start reading at **Galatians 6:7** and start examining yourself ... before it's too late.

It's <u>your</u> choice. You'll be reminded. But you'll need to listen. No one will force you to do this. However, if you <u>don't</u> want and work to obey God as He has said you should—you have chosen, unwisely. Ignorance is no excuse, so study! You are <u>in</u> the faith, or you are <u>out.</u> There is no in between. Well ... are you? Remember:

"Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith;" - 2 Cor 13:5

ARE YOU LISTENING?

Here's a verse that ought to get our attention:

"Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: - John 15:2

God, being spirit, wants (and requires!) **spiritual** fruit from us. Fruit that will make **us** more **pleasing** in **His** sight and **valuable** to Him and **worth** keeping. When we, as branches in Christ, have and abound in the spiritual qualities of: Mercy, faith, faithfulness, love, patience, meekness, hope, zeal, joy etc. God will be pleased because these are the things He **wants** from **us**. Here's what you should do:

- 1. First, you must want to bear good fruit (Proverbs 16:9)
- 2. Get your **heart** (the soil) ready (2 Peter 1:5-8)
- 3. Plant the right **seed** (Luke 8:11, Colossians 1:5,6)
- 4. Water and **nurture** the seed and the soil (1 Corinthians 3:6, 1 Peter 2:2)
- 5. **Recognize** good fruit, reject the poorer (Colossians 1:10, Titus 3:14)
- 6. Remember, the fruit is for **God**, we're just the servants (John 15:8)

That ye might be ... Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness" - Colossians 1:10,11

DO WHAT GOD WANTS! EXAMINE YOURSELF TO BE SURE.

"Blessed *is* that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing." - Luke 12:43

"Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. Those things, which ye have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of peace shall be with you." - Philippians 4:8,9

Note that the apostle says "<u>DO</u>". We *all* must be *doing* the things told us by the apostles in the Bible. Read your Bibles, learn what God wants of us and then **do it!** All of it!
