Without the Man there is No Plan

Scripture speaks of what we often refer to as "the plan of salvation." A passage such as 1 Peter 1:17-21 validates that idea. In this passage one clearly see's Jesus as the pinnacle of the plan to save us all from sin. But oddly and sadly enough Jesus is not given the honor He is due and worthy of receiving in regards to teaching the plan of salvation. The focus often centers on what His church is not supposed to be and not supposed to do instead of what Jesus died to make the church to be and commanded us to do. The idea of following Christ has given way to the repetition of the words "hear-believe-confess-repent-be baptized". Those words well summarize the process of obedience to Jesus but one can get so caught up in explaining the process the reason for it all doesn't get the glory He ought to get. We do not follow words, we follow Christ. The words of the Scriptures are invaluable, but if we look at them without considering Him we aren't using His Word as needed and/or intended.

As Jesus said in John 5:39-40 "You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me. But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life." We need the Bible to tell us of Christ, how to respond to Christ, how to live as one of His followers on earth so that we can live with Him forever in Heaven. But you see from John 5:39-40 it is entirely possible to be well-versed in the Bible and not well-versed in Christ. The apostle Paul similarly wrote in 2 Timothy 3:7 there are those who are "always learning and never able to come to the knowledge of the truth." Why so? A desire for knowledge, for being right, and for various other items is allowed to supersede a love for the Savior. We need to heed the message from Jesus to the church at Ephesus recorded in Revelation 2. In verses 2-3 Jesus praised them for some good works, labor, and patience, but then said this in verse 4, "Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love."

Christians aren't allowed to be people who leave our first love. If we love Christ properly we'll love, teach, and follow His plan properly accordingly.

Satan Must Love Calvinism

The doctrine of Calvinism is named after John Calvin, and its main points are Summarized by the acronym "TULIP" – Total hereditary depravity, Unconditional election, Limited atonement, Irresistible grace, and Perseverance of the saints. Calvinists believe that every single event, whether it is good or bad, happens because God ordained it to happen. This doctrine is deadly, and it seems to permeate nearly every denomination in one form or another. I am sure that Satan must love Calvinism, because it confuses people about the nature of God, His Plan of salvation, and so many other critical spiritual issues. Please notice some specific reasons why I believe that Satan must love Calvinism:

- Because it teaches that God causes people to be tempted, and makes them do evil things However, the Bible does not teach this! (James 1:13-16; 1 Peter 1:16, etc.).
- Because it teaches that people are basically nothing more than robots, having no free will of their own The Bible does not teach this! (Deuteronomy 30:19; Joshua 24:15; Acts 2:40, etc.).
- Because it teaches that innocent newborn babies have souls blackened with sin The Bible does not teach this! (2 Samuel 12:23; Ezekiel 18:20; Matthew 18:3, 19:14, etc.).
- Because it teaches that God will save certain people whom He chooses, without any conditions to be met on their part The Bible does not teach this! (Luke 13:3; Acts 2:38, 40; 2 Corinthians 7:1; James 4:8; Jude 21, etc.).
- Because it teaches that the Lord's invitation for salvation was only for individuals arbitrarily chosen by God to be saved The Bible does not teach this! (John 3:16; Matthew 11:28-30; Revelation 22:17).
- •Because it teaches that Jesus only died for individuals who were fortunate enough to be predestined for salvation by God The Bible does not teach this! (John 3:16; Hebrews 2:9; 1 John 2:1, 2, etc.).
- Because it teaches that God is a capricious respecter of persons when it comes to salvation, not desiring that all men be saved The Bible does not teach this! (John 3:16; Acts 10:34; Romans 2:11; 1 Timothy 2:4; 1 Peter 1:17; 2 Peter 3:9, etc.).
- Because it teaches that if God chooses one for salvation, God cannot be resisted The Bible does not teach this! (Luke 7:30; John 12:42, 43; Acts 7:51, 13:46, etc.).
- Because it attempts to denigrate the power of the Word and the need for spreading the Gospel Why labor to spread the Gospel when God will supposedly draw men to Him by a direct operation of the Holy Spirit? The Bible does not teach this! (John 6:45; Mark 16:15, 16; Matthew 28:19, 20; 2 Thessalonians 2:14; Romans 1:16, 10:17, etc.).
- Because it leads "the elect" to believe that there is no need for them to study the Word of God The Bible does not teach this! (1 Timothy 4:13; 2 Timothy 2:15, 3:16, 17, etc.).
- Because it teaches that once a person is saved, there is no possibility of falling from grace The Bible does not teach this! (Galatians 5:4; Hebrews 3:6, 4:11, 6:4-6, 10:25 -31, 10:35-39, 12:15, 12:25; 2 Peter 2:20-22; etc.).
