## Where In The Bible Will I Find... We are to Preach Christ, Not the Church?

The church of the Bible is not a denomination. In fact, the only reference to denominationalism in the New Testament <u>condemns</u> division (1 Corinthians 1:10-13).

"Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment." - 1 Corinthians 1:10

Many and various are the teachings of denominations concerning their thoughts on God's plan for saving the world. The different plans offered by men do not change God's divine plan in the least. Some teach babies should be "baptized" by sprinkling or the sinner should pray instead of obey or faith alone saves, which is expressly condemned in the Bible (James 2:14, 17, 20, 22, 24, 26) or that Jesus saves and not the church and one can be saved outside as well as in the church of Christ.

<u>None</u> of these are the plan brought to the earth by God. God sent His only begotten Son to seek and save the lost (John 3:16, Luke 19:10). God's plan was that Jesus should seek the lost by establishing the church. The church was planned, prophesied, promised, and predicted for several hundred years before its establishment. In Acts 2, the church is an established reality, and is represented as being the place prepared by Christ for the saved (Acts 2:41, 47).

The church is not a part of the plan of salvation. It <u>is</u> the plan of salvation. According to the Bible, men cannot be saved outside of Christ, the church, or body of Christ, which terms all refer to the place of salvation. The plan for entering the church of Christ includes a man hearing, believing in Christ with all of his heart, repentance, confession, and being baptized (Acts 8:35-39).

Jesus, in carrying out God's will, never promised to save anyone outside the church which He built with His teaching and purchased with His blood (Matthew 16:18 -19; 28:19-20; Acts 20:28). The church is the <u>only</u> institution over which He is head (Ephesians 1:22-23) and the <u>only</u> one on the earth now that He promised to save eternally (Ephesians 5:23). — (Continued on page 3)

With these thoughts clearly before us, one expresses his ignorance of the Scriptures who might say, "I am so glad to hear someone preach Jesus as the Saviour and not the Church as the Saviour." When deadly persecution arose with the stoning of Stephen, the members of the church at Jerusalem were "scattered abroad throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria..." and "went every where preaching the word" (Acts 8:1-4).

Preaching Christ and preaching the Word are one and the same (Acts 8:4-5) and the same as preaching the church or kingdom (Acts 8:12). It is important for us to study to be approved of God (2 Timothy 2:15)

# ARE YOU LISTENING?

Here's a verse that ought to get our attention:

"Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: - John 15:2

God, being spirit, wants (and requires!) *spiritual* fruit from us. Fruit that will make **us** more **pleasing** in **His** sight and **valuable** to Him and **worth** keeping. When we, as branches in Christ, have and abound in the spiritual qualities of: Mercy, faith, faith-fulness, love, patience, meekness, hope, zeal, joy etc. God will be pleased because these are the things He *wants* from **us**. Here's what you should do:

- 1. First, you must **want** to bear good fruit (Proverbs 16:9)
- 2. Get your heart (the soil) ready (2 Peter 1:5-8)
- 3. Plant the right **seed** (Luke 8:11, Colossians 1:5,6)
- 4. Water and **nurture** the seed and the soil (1 Corinthians 3:6, 1 Peter 2:2)
- 5. Recognize good fruit, reject the poorer (Colossians 1:10, Titus 3:14)
- 6. Remember, the fruit is for **God**, we're just the servants (John 15:8)
